Subject: Sale of Land by General Headquarters Approved Allottees

Further to our letter no. BAC/Policy/II/121/2002 dated 17 Jul 2002, BAC/Policy/II/46/2003 dated 30 Aug 2003, BAC/Policy/II/81/2004 dated 17 Jun 2004, BAC/Policy/II/97/2004 dated 11 Oct 2004 and BAC/Policy/II/9/2005 dated 23 Jul 2005.

1. According to General Headquarters policy any sale and purchase of allotted military land falling within 5 miles border belt is liable to be cancelled from the name of both sellers and purchasers in case "No Objection Certificate" has not been obtained from General Headquarters through Border Area Committee.
2. As per para 11 of Martial Law Regulation-9 of 1959 "The allotment shall be liable to be cancelled if the land is transferred by the allottee to any person without the permission of the General Headquarters". This instruction is valid for allottee, his legal heirs and on subsequent transfers as well.
3. In spite of repeated reminder and clear instructions on the subject, Halqa Patwaries and other Revenue Official are transferring the land without obtaining NOC from GHQ, which is a clear violation of rules and regulations. In future punitive action will be initiated against the concerned Halqa Patwaries and Revenue Officials in Punjab Anti Corruption Department in case of non compliance of said order.
