Subject: RESPONSIBILITY OF SUPERVISING OFFICERS

Kindly refer to the subject cited above.

It is requested that whenever a Patwari gets transferred and refuses to handover official consolidation record to the new incumbent and keeps the same in his illegal possession, this shall be the responsibility of concerned DDO (Cons)/Collector Consolidation and Consolidation Officer to get an FIR registered against such official. Follow up of such cases should also be made proactively. A complete list of FIRs against corrupt officials, suspended officials, and their current status should reach the office of Member Consolidation within a week positively.

Furthermore, it is being seen with great concern that undue leniency is usually shown while enquiring against corrupt officials. Chief Secretary Punjab has taken strong exception to this fact and recently ordered to charge sheet an EDO (R), and DO (R) for exonerating a Tehsildar and Patwari in an enquiry. This must be taken very seriously and no corrupt official should be allowed to go scot free.
