**NOTIFICATION**

No.2052-2012/ 777 LR-III. In exercise of the powers conferred under sections 55 and 182 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act 1967 (XVII of 1967) and after previous publication, the Board of Revenue, Punjab, with the previous approval of the Government, is pleased to direct that in the Punjab Land Revenue Rules, 1968, the following further amendments shall be made:

**AMENDMENTS**

In the said rules, in rule 9:

- (i) in sub-rule (2), for clause (a), the following shall be substituted:

"(a) The Revenue Officer shall record the statements of at least two respectable persons, preferably Lambardars or members of the local government, in respect of the legal heirs of the deceased; and, obtain their signatures or thumb impressions on the Register of Mutation and copies of Computerized National Identity Card and Form B or other similar documents of the deceased and his legal heirs in order to ensure that all the legal heirs of the deceased are correctly reflected in the mutation of inheritance;"

- (ii) after sub-rule (2), the following sub-rules (3), (4), (5) and (6) shall be inserted:

"(3) If the appellate or revisional authority, or any court while dealing with mutation of inheritance finds that any of the legal heirs of the deceased had not been entered in the mutation of inheritance by the Revenue Officer, it shall send a copy of its decision to the District Enforcement of Inheritance Rights Committee constituted under this rule.

(4) There shall be a District Enforcement of Inheritance Rights Committee (hereinafter called the "Committee") in each district consisting of the following:

received through any source, and if it is satisfied that any person was deprived of his inheritance rights by the Revenue Officer, or any other person with mala fide intention or owing to negligence, it shall recommend to the competent authority for initiation of criminal prosecution or disciplinary action against the Revenue Officer or any other person responsible for it.

(6) The Committee shall meet at least once in a month and shall send minutes of its meetings to the Chief Secretary, the Senior Members, Board of Revenue, the Director General, Anti-Corruption Establishment and the Commissioner."
