

To All District Collectors in the Punjab.

Subject: **GUIDELINES FOR DISTRIBUTION OF BUSINESS UNDER THE PUNJAB LAND REVENUE ACT, 1967 AND OTHER LAND LAWS AMONGST THE COLLECTORS OF DISTRICTS AND ADDITIONAL COLLECTORS OF THE DISTRICTS.**

Section 9(2) of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1967 as substituted by the Punjab Land Revenue (Amendment) Act 2011 provides as under:-

"The Government may appoint an Additional Collector of a District, who shall, subject to the general control of the Collector, exercise any of the powers and discharge any of the duties conferred or imposed on the Collector."


2. Pursuant to the provisions of section 13 of the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1967, the following guidelines are issued by the Board of Revenue, Punjab regarding allocation of judicial business amongst Collectors and Additional Collectors of the Districts.

A. Additional Collector of the District.

- (i) Matters pertaining to correction in revenue record.
- (ii) Suspension and remission of land revenue.
- (iii) Creation of demand of land revenue.
- (v) Exercise of the powers of Deputy Land Commissioners in the District.
- (vi) Declaration of outstanding government dues as arrears of land revenue.

B. Collector of the District.

- (i) Appointment of Lambardars.
- (ii) Review of Mutations.
- (iii) Appeals against the orders of Assistant Collectors of the first grade in cases of partition.
- (iv) Any other judicial case including any important case out of above categories mentioned under Additional Collector of the District may like to hear himself.
- (v) Collector of the District in a bigger District may transfer cases to Additional Collector if pendency increases in his Court.
