REGULATION NO. 121

Martial Law Regulation No. 115, as amended by Martial Law Regulation No. 121, shall further be amended as follows:-

In the said Regulation, in paragraph 1, after sub-paragraph(3), the following new sub-paragraph(4) shall be added and shall be deemed always to have been added, namely:-

" (4) Notwithstanding anything contained in sub-paragraphs (2) and (3), the provisions of this Regulation shall not be applicable, until the 31st day of October, 1972, within the District of Chitral in the North-West Frontier Province."
