I am directed to intimate that it has come to the notice of Chief Land Commissioner, Punjab, that Writ cases are treated as routine their disposal is not arranged well before the due date of hearing and the necessary material is not furnished by the local officers well in time for decision by the Chief Land Commissioner or the Land Commission as to what stand is to be taken in the matter before the High Court.

2. The Chief Land Commissioner has observed that all Writ matters pertaining to Land Reforms are of a vital nature and should be given special attention. They should not be treated as a routine but should immediately be dealt with personally by all concerned. The Chief Land Commissioner has therefore, directed that you may please furnish necessary material/information promptly to enable this Secretariat to obtain orders of Chief Land Commissioner or Land Commission as envisaged in paragraph 1 above.
