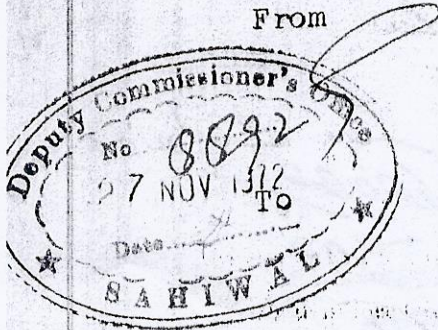

Subject:- Process of summons.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to this Secretariat circular letter No. ASR-II-2929/72/3332-LC(II), dated the 19th August, 1972, on the above subject and to state that it has come to the notice of the Chief Land Commissioner and Legal Advisor to Punjab Land Commission that instructions already issued are not followed and the summons issued in judicial cases are not returned after service. If at all they are returned, they are despatched so late, that they reach the courts of the Chief Land Commissioner/Legal Advisor after the date fixed for hearing, had expired. The result is that in the absence of the returned summons, the courts cannot take any action against the defaulting parties even if their service had been affected in time. You are therefore requested to instruct the concerned officials to return the summons immediately after effecting service upon the parties, so as to reach the court issuing the summons, at least two days before the date fixed for hearing.
