Sir,

I am directed to invite attention to this Secretariat  
letter No. ASR-II-5106/72/6494-LC(II), dated the 16th December,  
1972, on the above subject and to clarify that in cases where  
an appeal/revision has been filed with the Chief Land Commis-  
sioner, the land in dispute may be resumed but should not be  
disposed of under paragraph 18 of Martial Law Regulation 115.  
In case the appeal/revision is rejected by the Chief Land  
Commissioner, formal allotment order should immediately be  
issued in favour of the grantee under paragraph 18(1) and (2)  
or paragraph 18(3) as the case may be. In case the appeal/  
revision is accepted, the resumption order should be vacated.
