SUBJECT: SERVICE OF SUMMONS ETC.

My dear Deputy Land Commissioner,

I am desired to refer to this Secretariat letter No. ASR-II-2929/72/5432-LC(II), dated the 19th August, 1972 pointing out that -

- a) the office records of the lower court relating to appeals/revisions fixed for hearing before the Chief Land Commissioner are not sent regularly in advance.
- b) the summons sent for service of the parties by the Judicial Officers in this office are invariably not returned duly processed after service.

It was requested that you may kindly look into the matter personally; take suitable steps to ensure that the record alongwith summons after service were duly returned at least 4 days before the date for regular hearing of appeal/revision to avoid inconvenience to the Chief Land Commissioner.

In spite of the above instructions, the situation has further deteriorated and the Chief Land Commissioner has taken a very serious view of it.

I shall be most grateful if you will kindly look into the matter personally and take suitable steps to ensure compliance of the instructions issued in the letter cited above and steps taken are intimated to me.
