**TOP PRIORITY**

Subject: Concession on account of Thur/Sem affected areas in Lyallpur District.

Mr. A.G. RIZA, CHIEF LAND COMMISSIONER, PUNJAB.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to your Memorandum No.5607/LA dated 16th November, 1973, on the above subject and to intimate that the Chief Land Commissioner, Punjab has observed that the correct position with regards to points (a), (b) and (c) raised by you is as under :-

- (a) Since the operation in respect of land reforms pertains to a declarant, it is the holding of the declarant which has to be taken into account for purposes of determining the benefit of reduction in P.L.U.s for thur & sem and not the village as a whole. It may also be that in the holding some areas are affected by thur and sem. Therefore, the actual unit which is affected by thur and sem should be taken into account.
- (b) & (c) The emphasis in the provision of exception in the Booklet of Produce Index Units is on the expression "actually affected by sem thur". The Deputy Land Commissioner has, therefore, to ascertain what is the actual extent of effect of thur and sem on a particular land and he is to be guided by the realities and factuality of situation and is not bound by the entry in the khasra girdawari or the record of Reclamation Department if it is established that such an entry or the record is factually incorrect. Between khasra girdawari and record of Reclamation Department, if the latter is considered by the Deputy Land Commissioner to be generally more reliable he can certainly rely on that.
