My dear Deputy Land Commissioner,

I am directed to inform you that in reviewing the slow progress of land reforms work in the districts, the Minister for Revenue has been pleased to observe that poor performance in an important area of Government activity cannot be tolerated. He has, therefore, directed that more stringent action may have to be taken against the officers and officials concerned by equating negligence with wilful sabotage of Government reforms.

The observations and directions of the Revenue Minister may, therefore, please be taken note of and be brought to the notice of all officers and officials dealing with Land Reforms work. They may further be directed to give Top Priority and serious attention to this work in order to complete all aspects of it without further delay.
