I am directed to state that the question regarding amendment of Martial Law Regulation 115 of 1972 to provide for the disposal of areas under occupancy tenants/muqarraridars surrendered by landlords under the aforesaid Regulation is under consideration of Government. It has been decided that meantime status quo should be maintained in all such cases and the pending cases should also not be disposed of until further orders.

There being no special areas in the Punjab, the Ala Malkiyat and similar other intermediary interests were abolished by the operation of paragraph 22, read with paragraph 1 (2) of the repealed Martial Law Regulation 64 of 1955. Hence so far as Punjab is concerned, the proposed amendments in Martial Law Regulation 115 will affect occupancy tenants/muqarraridars only.
