I am directed to inform you that it has come to the notice of Chief Minister Punjab that some Deputy Land Commissioners, on the pretext that they were pre-occupied with the wheat procurement drive, in-ordinately delayed the implementation of land reforms work and allotment of land to tenants and other eligible persons.

The Chief Minister has taken a serious view of this and has desired that all the District Officers should be directed to give high priority to land reforms work in view of the importance attached to it by the Prime Minister and complete it without any further delay.
