Subject:- Utilization of resumed land for public purposes.

Mr. A. G. Riza, Senior Member, Board of Revenue and Chief  
Land Commissioner, Punjab.

Sir,

I am directed to state that a question has been raised whether the resumed land that may be utilized for public purposes under proviso to sub-paragraph (3) of paragraph 18 of Martial Law Regulation 115 is to be given free of cost or on payment.

2. The question was considered and the Punjab Land Commission in its meeting held on 26th September, 1974, approved the proposal that in this respect the policy applicable to other State land as elucidated in Financial Commissioner's Standing Order No. 28 and the Colony Pamphlet Volume-I may be followed, i.e. in all such cases where State land is normally given free of charge for public purposes, e.g. graveyard etc. the resumed land should also be given free of charge and in cases where the land is sold against payment, the price of resumed land should be recovered on the same pattern as for other State land.

3. I am, therefore, to request that as and when any resumed land is required for a public purpose, a detailed reference should be made to this Secretariat, keeping

in view the aforesaid decision of the Punjab Land  
Commission.
