NOTIFICATION.

Lahore, dated the 10th June, 1966.

No. 1072-96/ 1426 -E(F)V. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-Section (2)&(3) of Section 15 of Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1967 (West Pakistan Act, XVII of 1967), the Government of the Punjab is pleased to confer powers of Assistant Collector 1st Grade under Sections 80 to 112 of Land Revenue Act, 1967 on all the officers i.e. Tehsildars and Extra Assistant Commissioners who hold the charge of post of Sub-Registrars at District Headquarters in the Province. These powers will be exercised for the recovery of deficient amounts of stamp duty (under Stamp Act, 1899) and registration fee (under Registration Act, 1908) detected in respect of the documents registered by sub-Registrars. They will perform their duties under overall supervision and control of the District Collector concerned.

2. Board of Revenue, Punjab's Notification No. 2470-88/1552-E(F)III, dated 26.4.1966 is withdrawn.
