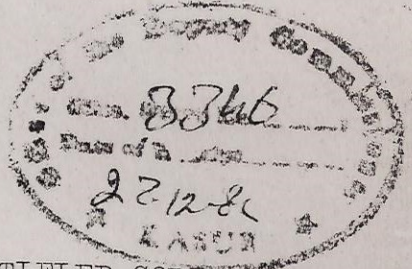

PAYMENT OF STAMP DUTY ON CERTIFIED COPIES  
OF DEEDS ISSUED BY REGISTRATION OFFICES.

Reference:-

Punjab Government Notification No. 2871-85/  
809-ST(I), dated 18-7-1985.

Memorandum.

It has been noticed that some confusion exists in some districts about the mode of payment of stamp duty on certified photostat copies of deeds registered under the Registration Act, 1908.

It is clarified that an amendment was made in Rule 17(e) of the Pakistan Stamp Rules, 1925, through Government Notification mentioned above whereby it has been made possible to pay stamp duty in the form of court fee adhesive stamp of Rs.4/- instead of a Non-Judicial stamp of Rs.4/-, by affixing the same on the photostat copies of registered deeds. These court fee stamps shall be punched and cancelled by the official in the manner prescribed in Section 30 of the Court Fees Act. Attaching a Non-Judicial stamp paper of Rs.4/- with photostat copies of registered deeds is now irregular and should be stopped forthwith.
