Vide this circular the Finance Department has issued a Correction Slip No. 145 Chart of Classification for the following property transactions-

- iv) Reconveyance of mortgaged property.
- v) Release.
- vi) Settlements.
- vii) Surrender of lease.
- viii) Transfer of lease.
- ix) Transfer of property rights.
- x) Exchange of property rights.
- x i) Gift.
- xii) Lease.
- xiii) Partition of property-

For this purpose a New detailed Sub-head "0270000/0271000/0271801- Non Judicial- Sale of property transactions, has been allotted for posting of receipt of stamp duty of the above noted property transactions under this head. It has been noticed that the receipt of stamp duty on this head of account has not so far being posted under the said head.
